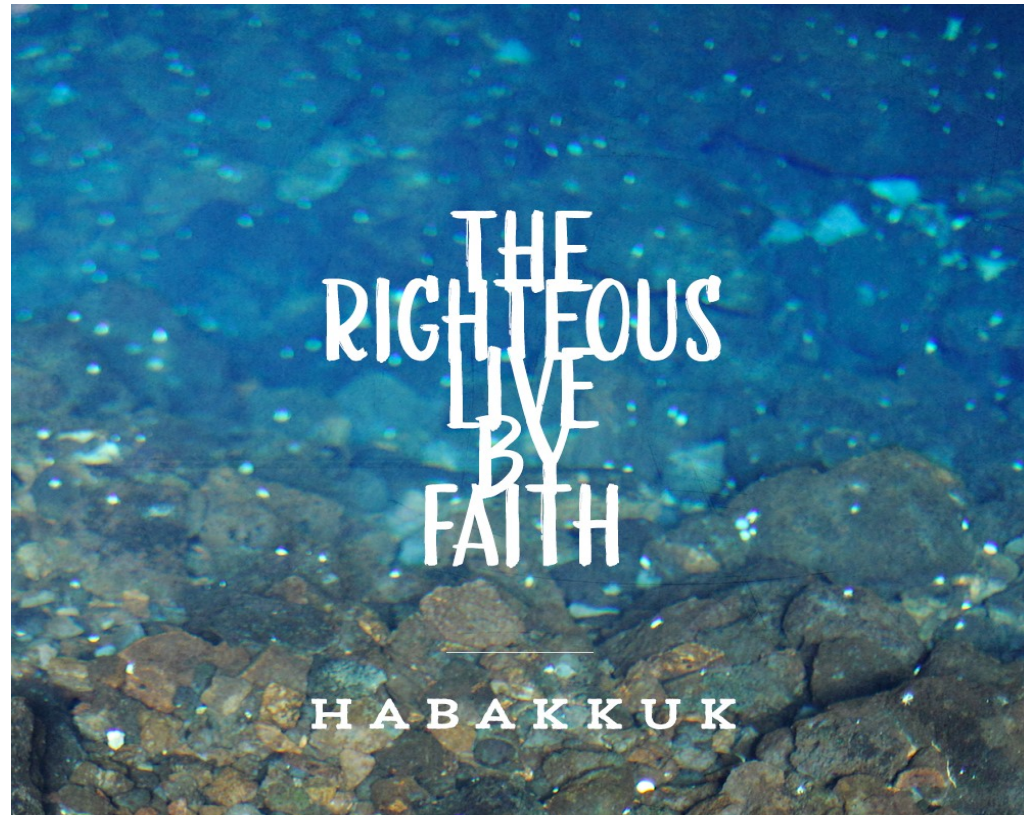
Sugar, Flour and Taco seasoning in packets
