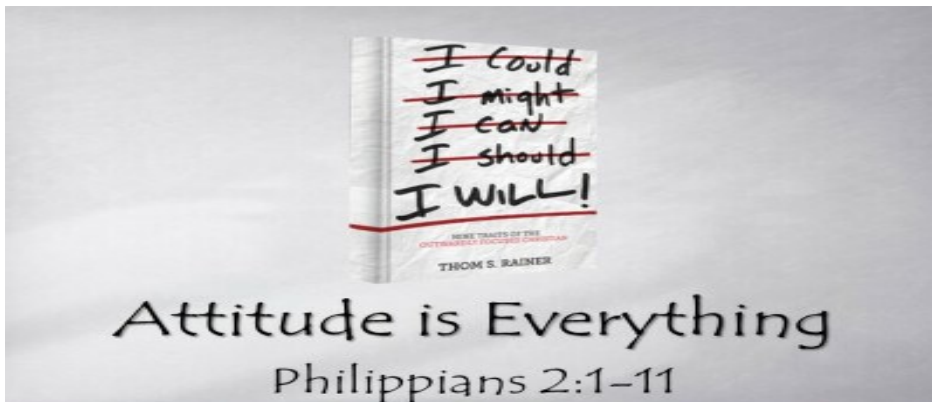
*Our July 14th church service will move to the Canistota Legion Hall for the Community Worship Service at 10 am.
