People need your love, dear God. We live in a time when people are divided and it sometimes seems like no one cares about anyone else. Send us your love to help unite your people. Send us your Spirit to stir within us a caring heart. Send us out to be your love to a world in need. Amen.

CARING CONVERSATION

Take a moment to check in with each other or to use the questions below.

- P Highs & Lows: What made you happy today? What made you sad?
- Thinking about This Week's Story: It matters to God and to our community in how we treat other people. Can you name one way at work or school that you responded to someone with kindness? Forgiveness? Love?
- Getting Ready for Next Week's Story: Jesus teaches the people about the kingdom of God through a series of parables or small stories. Tell a brief story from your day.

DAILY BIBLE READING

Read aloud from the DAILY BIBLE READING from the front. What do you want to remember from this reading?

PRAY TOGETHER

Hold hands and pray: Dear God, thank you for	and help us	
Amen.		

CLOSING

 $\boldsymbol{\vartheta}$ If you used a candle, extinguish it as a sign of the end of the devotion time.
