Think about devotions as a continuation of our community's worship. The following basic pattern could be one way of forming your household's devotions. Adapt as necessary!

GATHERING

♣ Light a candle to help you focus this time as "God time."

God, show us how to follow you. Give us the courage and the faith to do the work no matter how hard it may be. Remind us that your beloved Son, Jesus, is always with us and that you are well-pleased with him and that you are well-pleased with us. Amen.

CARING CONVERSATION

Take a moment to check in with each other or to use the questions below.

- P Highs & Lows: What was the best part of today? What was the worst?
- Thinking about This Week's Story: We called to follow Jesus and to listen to him. What is the hardest part in following Jesus today? How can you listen to him better?
- **Getting Ready for Next Week's Story:** Did someone ask you for forgiveness today? Did you forgive them? Did you need forgiveness from someone?

DAILY BIBLE READING

Read aloud from the DAILY BIBLE READING from the front. What do you want to remember from this reading?
