CARING CONVERSATION

Take a moment to check in with each other or to use the questions below.

- **?** Highs & Lows: What made you happy today? What made you angry?
- Thinking about This Week's Story: In the story that Jesus tells, some of the workers did not think it was fair that everyone got paid the same, even the workers that did not work all day. What happened to you today that seemed fair? What happened that seemed unfair?
- Getting Ready for Next Week's Story: Did you receive an invitation today? Maybe you were invited to eat lunch with someone or share in class or at work? Did you accept their invitation? If not, why?

DAILY BIBLE READING

Read aloud from the DAILY BIBLE READING from the front. What do you want to remember from this reading?

PRAY TOGETHER

¹ Using the service project list, pray for all the unfair ways of the world.

CLOSING

✤ If you used a candle, extinguish it as a sign of the end of the devotion time.
